

SPCA Rescues Dogs From Abandoned Home

On Tuesday March 5, 2013, officers of the Hudson Valley SPCA Humane Law Enforcement Division say they rescued a 1-year-old female Stafford Terrier named Momma, and a 3-year-old male Stafford Terrier named Bengal, from what can only be described as horrific conditions from Middletown home. Both dogs were seized with a search warrant. The dogs were reportedly kept in a house where the owners had aban-

doned the animals 30 days prior. The house is said to have had no heat or electric service, and the dogs were kept in a garage with two inches of standing water and fecal matter covering the floor. The dogs are being treated for medical conditions related to their captivity. Anyone with knowledge of the dogs or the whereabouts of their owners is asked to call (845) 448-2548.
